Our learning focus in English:

All year one classes will be establishing and setting up their Reading and Writing Processes which will support a smooth and effective running of the English lessons.

As mentioned earlier, the Home Reading Program will begin in week 3. Students will be encouraged to change their books at the beginning of each school day from the trolleys located outside their classroom.

Our learning focus in Mathematics:

Students will focus to develop confidence with number sequences to and from 100 by ones and also skip count by twos, fives and tens starting from zero.

Students will work towards developing fluency with forwards and backwards counting in meaningful contexts by playing games such as Buzz, Kings and Queens and Dice Game.

Our Inquiry based learning will focus on:

The Quality Beginning Program which includes setting up and establishing process that will foster and support a smooth running of the classroom programs. Students will determine what an effective classroom looks like, sounds like and feels like?
