With regards to Fun Day, one parent helper per class will be required.

Our learning focus in English (over the next 2 weeks):

In Writing students will be encouraged to reread their own writing to check for correct use of punctuation. The correct use of full stops and capital letters in writing will be modelled during the whole class focus. During daily sharing students will discuss the strategies they may have used to decide when and where to use capital letters and full stops.

In Writing students will continue to *unpack writing seeds* with their classroom teacher using the Deb Sukarna model of the Writer's Notebook. Teachers will also demonstrate how to use teaching tools such as the P (plus), M (minus) and I (interesting) to explain our thinking during the writing process.

In Reading teachers will model and explain explicitly to students what fluency is, how it sounds, and why it is important. Using punctuation such as full stops, commas, exclamation marks and question marks, enhances our understanding of what we read.

In Spelling students are learning that the diagraph th is made up of two letters that make one sound. Refer to Compass post at the end of term 3 for full details about spelling this term.

Our learning focus in Mathematics over the next two weeks will be:

In Number and Algebra students will:

- learn about making a group to show equal halves using pictures and materials
- create fact families that show addition and subtraction for a single number

In Measurement and Geometry students will understand:

- about shapes within 3D objects
- vocabulary used and needed to describe shapes.
- about the faces of 3D shapes
